HOLY COW! AN INDIAN ADVENTURE

(Bantam, 320 pages, softcover)

"This summer I'm reading Holy Cow, by Sarah Macdonald, the 2004 travelogue of a young Australian woman who visits India at 21 and swears never to return. She is compelled to some years later after her fiancé, a journalist, is assigned to Delhi.

"Macdonald's lengthy stay in the country becomes a spiritual quest for self-discovery and we experience the complex paradox that is India, the sacred and the profane, unfiltered through her eyes - the pollution, the heat, and the poverty as well as the beauty, the humanity, and the profound wisdom.

"Macdonald recounts her experiences in a direct style rich with humour and human emotion that kept me reading. As a third-generation North American of Indian descent who has never been to the subcontinent, I was profoundly moved and I think any reader would be similarly affected."
